About the LYWB

The London Youth Wind Band was formed in 2003 as a companion ensemble to the London Schools Symphony Orchestra, providing wider opportunities for wind, brass and percussion players to work at the high musical levels achieved by the LSSO and to perform in major venues. Both groups are organised by the Centre for Young Musicians – a Division of the Guildhall School. Auditions take place in the autumn each year in conjunction with those for the LSSO.

Members of the LYWB come from all over the capital and meet twice a year during school holidays to rehearse and perform a range of music from traditional marches and original works for band through to music from stage and screen. Leading professional players and young artists from the Guildhall School, appear as soloists with the band.

The LYWB has performed at the Royal Albert Hall, St. John's, Smith Square, St. James's, Piccadilly, and St. Alfege, Greenwich. The band has also given special performances for young children in London schools and undertaken concert tours to France, Germany, Holland, Belgium and the Czech Republic.
